UP 18-02: Quick-Service Drive Thru Restaurant - The Oroville Planning Commission 8.2 reviewed and considered approving Use Permit No. 18-02 for the operation of a quickservice drive thru restaurant at 1355 Washington Avenue (APN: 013-030-010). The subject property has a zoning designation of Corridor Mixed Use (MXC) and a General Plan land use designation of Mixed Use. Per the City of Oroville Municipal Code, the proposed restaurant is a use permitted by right, subject to a zoning clearance. However, all drive thru establishments require approval of a conditional use permit in an MXC zone. (Gary Layman, Chief Building Official)
