City of Oroville Interactive Map

The City of Oroville has provided this interactive map to help you explore the population of the city. Using this map, you will also be able to see Community of Interest (COI) testimony that has been submitted and street-level detail of draft maps of the City Council districts.

How to Use the Map

- Navigate to the map's site https://www.cityoforoville.org/services/information-technology-it-department/geographic-information-systems-gis/web-maps/districting-map
- When the map opens, you will see shapes with numbers in them on a map of the city of Oroville.
 The shapes represent Census Block Groups, and the numbers list the population count in each block group.
- To view Draft Maps and COI testimony, click the arrows/chevrons in the upper left hand corner of the map. A list of layers should appear. Note the box next to layer called "Oroville Census Block Groups" has a check mark in it. That indicates that the layer is turned on.
- To turn the Block Groups layer off, click the name of that layer. The check mark should disappear along with the map boundaries of the census block groups and the population counts.
- Click on the name of any other layer you would like to view, including Community of Interest testimony and the Draft Maps.
- You can also search by location to zoom the map into your area of interest by entering an
 address into the "Search by Address" tool on the upper right-hand corner of the map and
 clicking the icon of the magnifying glass.
