



CHECK FOR PROPER CART PLACEMENT

- Carts should be placed in the street with the wheels touching the curb.
- The lid should open to the street with the handle in the back.
- Don't block the sidewalk.
- Don't park cars within three feet of carts.
- Place carts three feet apart.
- Put carts out by 6 AM on your pickup day.
- Remove carts from the curb as soon as possible after pickup and place them out of view from the street.

NO OLEANDERS OR PALM FRONDS

Oleander and Palm Fronds are not allowed into the green organics carts, both must go into the gray garbage cart.

Oleanders are poisonous and can contaminate the final compost product.

Palm fronds cannot go in your green waste cart because they are difficult to compost. They are hard to run through a chipper and they take a very long time to decompose.
