City plans public meeting on proposed aquatic center

OROVILLE » City officials are reaching out to the community to attend a meeting next month and provide input on a proposed aquatic center.

The Supplemental Benefits Fund steering committee have been talking about building a major swimming and athletics outlet in the area for several months.

Last February, the SBF committee approved a grant for a landscape and architectural design.

One proposed site is near the North Thermalito Forebay. The project is separate from the existing Forebay Aquatic Center.

Officials have said previously that the project would cost a lot, but SBF coordinator Bob Marciniak indicated recently that the funding may be available within six months to 18 months, whenever the Oroville Dam Facility relicensing process is complete.

There will be two meetings on from 3:30-5 p.m. and 6:30-8 p.m. on Dec. 10 at the Monday Club, 2385 Montgomery St.
