  - Location provides a nexus to Oroville, Chico, Durham & Butte College
- Visited Gauche Aquatic Park (GAP) in Yuba City
  - Construction cost \$18.0 million
  - 8.7 acres
  - 10 lane/25 yard swimming & diving pool
  - Zero depth entry children's activity pool with a two lane warm-up & teaching pool
  - 24 foot high water slide into a receiving pool

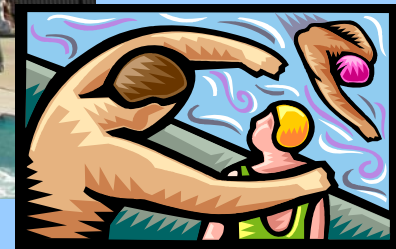

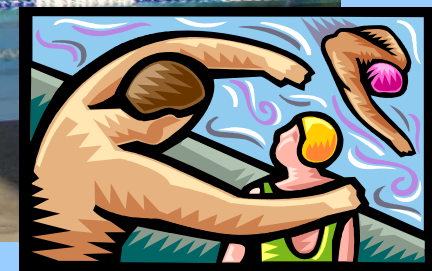
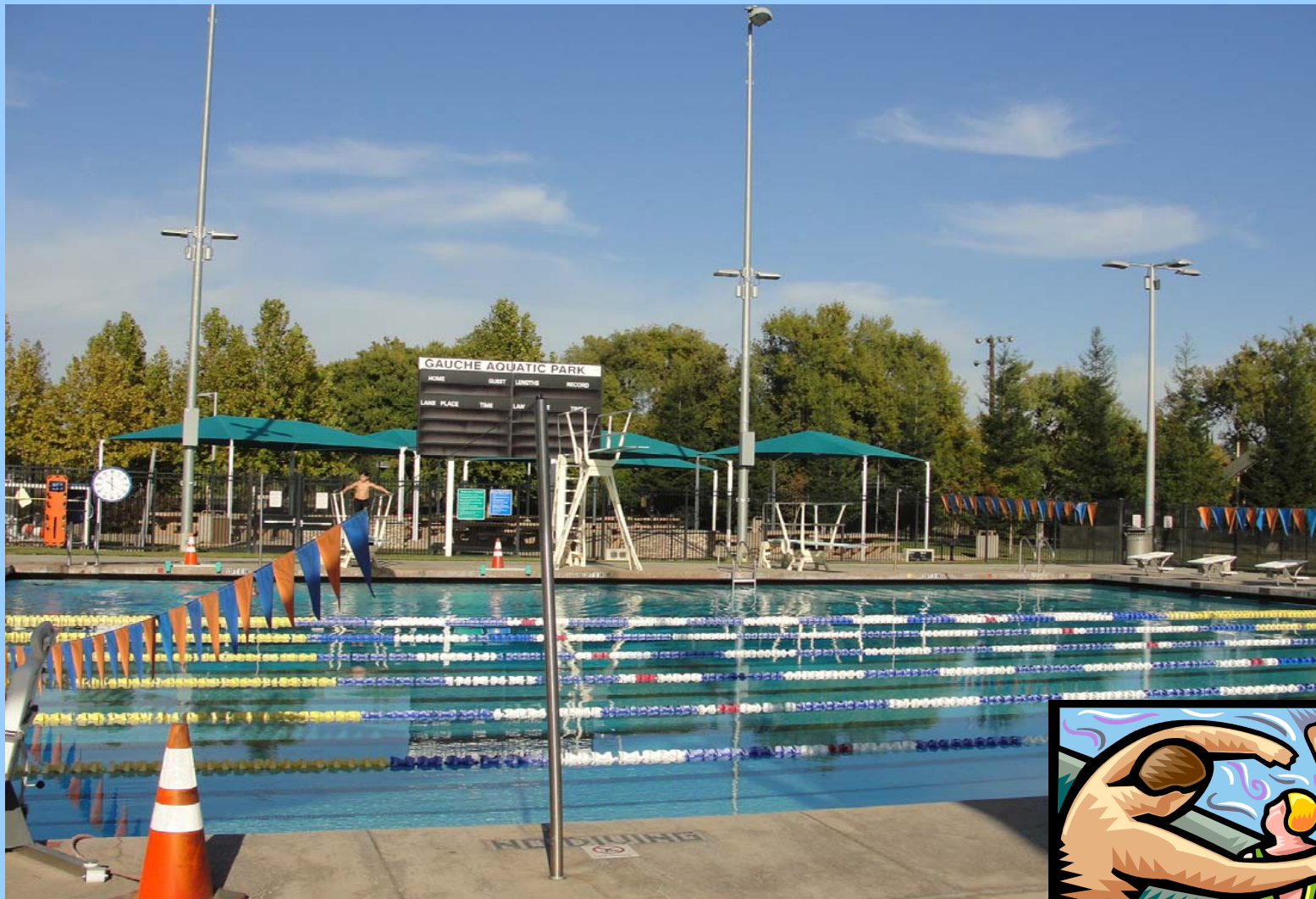
